

# Road Construction Alert

**Beginning November 4, 2016**, the City of High Point is closing Main Street between Westwood Avenue and Parkway Avenue due to road construction. The closing is expected to last for approximately 140 days with completion scheduled for early spring.

Patients and visitors will not be able to access the Millis Regional Health Education Center, Rehab Center, Wound Center or Community Clinic parking lots from their Main Street entrances during this time.

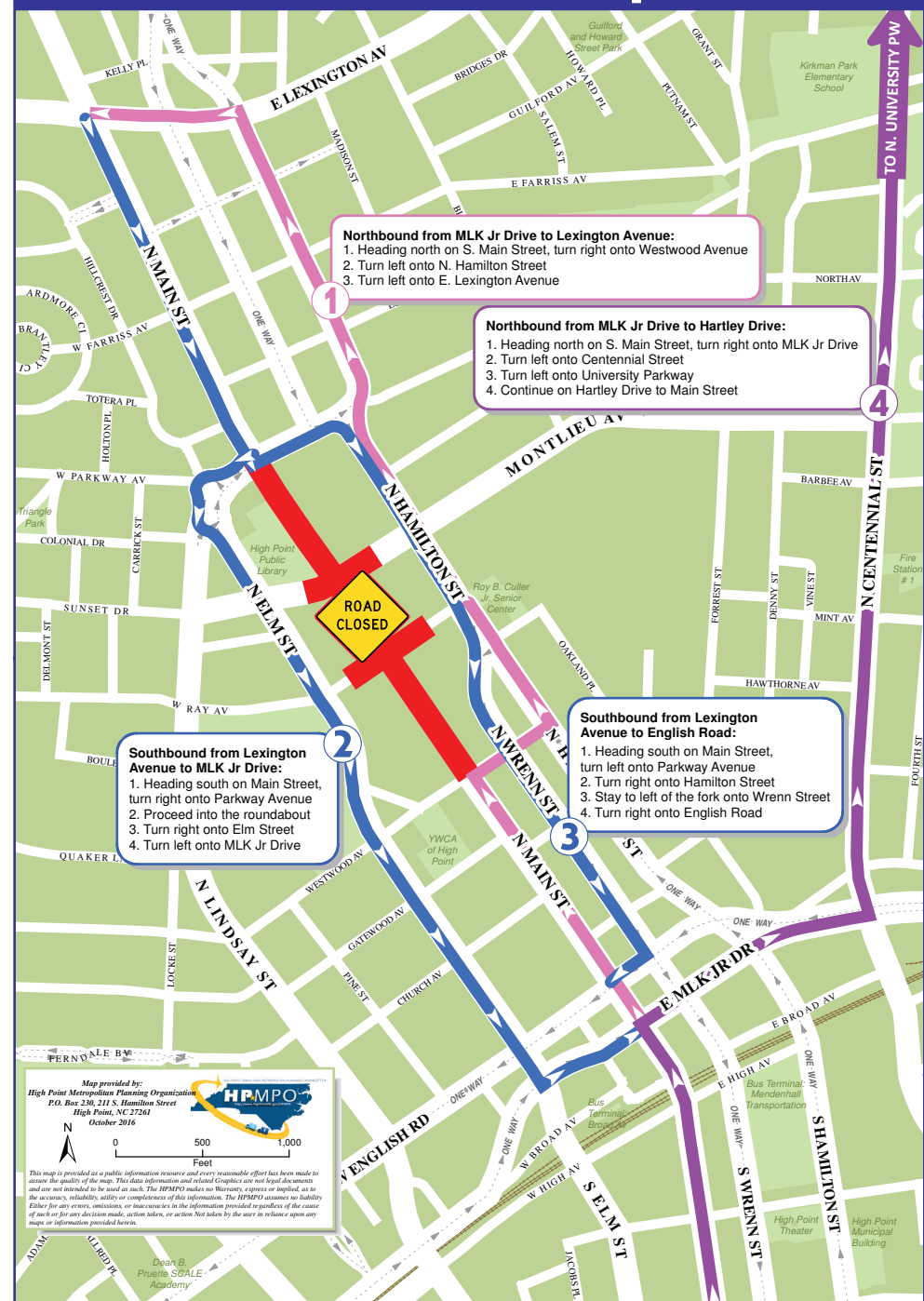
All parking lot access points on Elm Street and Westwood Avenue will remain open.

Please pay close attention to the detour signs as you travel to and from the hospital campus and exercise caution due to increased traffic.

# Main Street Closure Detour Options



**Northbound from MLK Jr Drive to Lexington Avenue:**  
1. Heading north on S. Main Street, turn right onto Westwood Avenue  
2. Turn left onto N. Hamilton Street  
3. Turn left onto E. Lexington Avenue

**Northbound from MLK Jr Drive to Hartley Drive:**  
1. Heading north on S. Main Street, turn right onto MLK Jr Drive  
2. Turn left onto Centennial Street  
3. Turn left onto University Parkway  
4. Continue on Hartley Drive to Main Street

**Southbound from Lexington Avenue to MLK Jr Drive:**  
1. Heading south on Main Street, turn right onto Parkway Avenue  
2. Proceed into the roundabout  
3. Turn right onto Elm Street  
4. Turn left onto MLK Jr Drive

**Southbound from Lexington Avenue to English Road:**  
1. Heading south on Main Street, turn left onto Parkway Avenue  
2. Turn right onto Hamilton Street  
3. Stay to left of the fork onto Wrenn Street  
4. Turn right onto English Road
